KC Men's Basketball Begins - Thursday, 11/4 at 8 PM

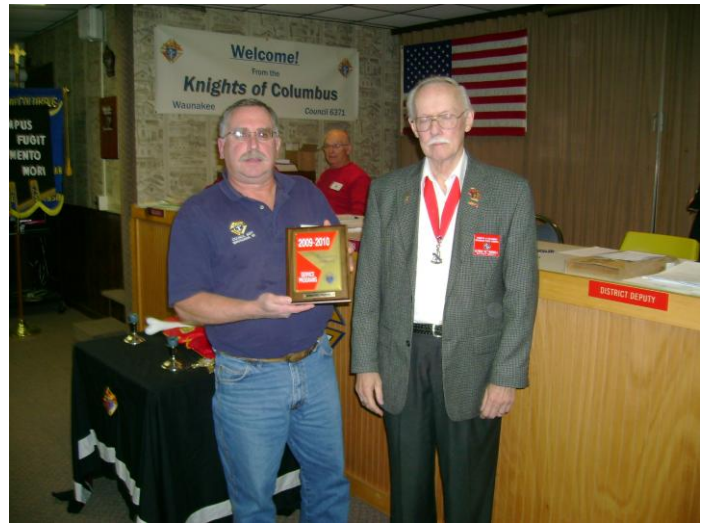
We will be beginning our traditional pick-up basketball night on Thursdays at St. John's gym. See you there.
